**Total Balance Sheet Assets,
2018, 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022:
Top 300 Insurer Groups Worldwide**

Insuramore's analysis of total balance sheet assets of insurer groups in 2022 – with comparative data also included for 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021 – covers up to the top 300 groups worldwide by this measure. Together, these 300 groups reported total assets with a combined global value of USD 38.6 trillion in 2022.

For insurers owned by banking / postal service groups or by diversified conglomerates with extensive non-financial interests, total assets are for those groups' insurance interests, not for the groups as a whole.

For insurer groups with financial year ends that occur in a month other than December, Insuramore presents data that includes a part of 2023 (e.g. end of March 2023 for many Japan-based groups).

In 2022, the top 300 insurer groups by this measure segmented by type and by home region as shown in the charts overleaf.
